Heart Quilt Sew Along

Finished Size: 52" x 61" (30) 8" square finished blocks

Hosted by Sharon Holland & Maureen Cracknell with the permission of Cluck Cluck Sew

Materials List

- •10 fat quarters for hearts
- · 2-²/₃ yards for background
- $\cdot \frac{1}{2}$ yard for binding
- · 3-¼ yards for backing
- •58" x 67" batting

Read through all instructions before beginning. Remove selvages. Sew pieces right sides together and use an accurate $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance *following the Cluck Cluck Sew instructions.



Cutting

- •From each of the 10 fat quarters, cut:
 - $> (2) 8 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 21" strips then cut into
 - (6) $8-\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4-\frac{1}{2}$ " (directional) rectangles.
- •From the background fabric, cut:
 - » Cut (7) $4-\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips then cut into (60)
 - 4-1/2" squares.
 - » Cut (6) $3-\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips for borders.
 - » Cut (23) 1- $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips then cut 9 strips into (35) 1- $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8- $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for horizontal sashing
 - and 5 strips into (120) 1- $\frac{1}{2}$ ' squares. Reserve the
 - remaining 9 strips for the vertical sashing.
- •From the binding, cut:
 - » Cut (6) 2-1/4" x 42" strips.
