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## \#20 IRISH CHAIN VARIATION



Material List

- (16) 2-1/2" squares and (8) 1-1/2" squares fabric A
- (5) $2-1 / 2$ " squares and (8) 1-1/2" squares fabric $B$
- (2) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (2) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips for frames

Read through all instructions before beginning. Remove selvages. Sew pieces right sides together and use a $1 / 4$ " seam throughout unless otherwise stated.

Four Patch Units
Noting placement, sew (2) 1-1/2"
fabric A squares to (2) $1-1 / 2, "$ fabric $B$ squares, alternating paired squares as shown into 2 rows of 2 squares each. Join rows to make a Four Patch unit. Make a total of 4 Four Patch units.


Block Assembly

1. Referring to the Block Assembly Diagram, and noting orientation, sew (3) 2-1/2" fabric A squares between 2 Four Patch units to make row A . Make a total of 2 A rows.
2. Sew (2) $2-1 / 2$ " fabric $B$ squares alternately between (3) 2-1/2" fabric A squares to make row B. Make a total of 2 B rows.
3. Sew (1) $2-1 / 2$ "' fabric B square between (4) $2-1 / 2$ "' fabric A squares to make row C. Join the rows to make the block.
4. Stitch the (2) $1-1 / 2 " \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ framing strips to opposite sides of
the block. Stitch the (2) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ $12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ framing strips to the remaining sides of the block.

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
