## \#5 JULY FOURTH



Material List

- (6) $2-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares fabric $A$
- (1) $5-1 / 4$ " square fabric B
- (2) $2-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares and (4) 2-1/2" squares fabric $C$
- (2) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2$ " rectangles and (2) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for frame

Read through all instructions before beginning. Remove selvages. Sew pieces right sides together and use a $1 / 4$ " seam throughout unless otherwise stated.

Flying Geese Units

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (4) $2-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ fabric $A$ squares.
2. Place a marked A square right sides together on the corner of the $5-1 / 4$ " fabric B square. In the same manner, place another marked A square in the opposite corner as shown.

3. Sew a $1 / 4$ " seam on each side of the drawn line. Cut apart on the line. Open and press. Makes 2 Flying Geese sections.

4. Noting orientation of the drawn line, place a marked A square right side together on the fabric B corner of one Flying Geese section as shown. Sew a $1 / 4$ " seam on each side of the drawn line. Cut apart on the line to make 2 Flying Geese
units. Open and press. Repeat step 4 with the remaining section for a total of 4 .


## Half-Square Triangles

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of both $2-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ fabric A squares. Place a marked square right sides together with a $2-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ fabric C square. Sew a $1 / 4$ " seam on each side of the drawn line. Cut apart on the line. Makes 2 half-square triangle (HST) units. Make a total of 4 HST units.


Block Assembly

1. Noting placement and orientation, sew 1 Flying Geese unit, 1 HST unit and (1) 2-1/2" fabric

C square together as shown in the Block Assembly Diagram to make 1 section. Make a total of 4 sections.
2. Noting placement and orientation, sew the sections into 2 rows of 2 sections each. Join the rows to make the block.
3. Stitch the (2) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ framing strips to opposite sides of the block. Stitch the (2) $2-1 / 2 " \times$ $12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ framing strips to the remaining sides of the block.
